## How it works



### 1. Choose items

### 2. Let us know

Register your gift drive and we'll connect you with the most suitable community service.



### 3. Donate

Deliver your collected items to the allocated service at an agreed upon time.



### 4. Where it's needed most

Your donated items are shared with those who need them most.

## Drop-off locations

Once you've registered your gift drive, we'll share the address to your closest drop-off location. We currently have collection points at:

- Brisbane City (Fortitude Valley)
- Brisbane South or South-West
- The Gold Coast



## Gifting guidelines

To ensure donations are safe and suitable, please only gift **new, unopened or in good condition second-hand items**. We do not accept items that are broken, damaged, ripped, stained or in any way faulty.

### In order of most needed

#### 1. Gift vouchers

Supermarkets  
Department stores  
Petrol stations  
Entertainment (e.g., Hoyts)  
Visa/EFTPOS

#### 4. New personal toiletries

Deodorant, body wash, soap, shampoo and conditioner  
Period products  
Toothpaste and toothbrushes  
Make up, moisturiser, make up remover wipes

#### 7. Clothing

Quality clean women's, men's and children's clothing  
Shoes  
Accessories

#### 2. Non-perishable food

Pasta and pasta sauce  
Rice, curry and stir-fry sauce  
Water, long-life and flavoured milk  
Tinned goods (e.g., fish, veggies, meats, soups & fruit)

#### 5. Toys

Wooden and plastic items  
Jigsaw puzzles  
Sporting equipment  
Balls  
Duplo, Mega Blocks, and other construction toys  
Loose items (e.g., animals, play kitchen items)  
Bikes, scooters and trikes  
Books

#### 8. Small household items

Plates  
Cutlery (butter knife only, not sharp)  
Glasses  
Mugs  
Cookware  
Kids themed

#### 3. School supplies

Pens, pencils and pencil case  
Sharpener, erasers and glue  
Ruler, highlighters and textas  
Lunch boxes and water bottles  
Exercise and and scrap books

#### 6. New baby items

Nappies, baby wipes  
Newborn baby and toddler clothes  
Wraps, blankets, cot bedding, change mats  
Baby wash, moisturiser, nappy cream  
Bottles, bibs, feeding equipment

#### 9. Second-hand items

Clothes, shoes and accessories (from babies to adults)  
Homewares  
Toys, bikes, books, highchairs, prams, strollers  
Bedding
